The sentence "Dogs being male and older are two potential significant factors associated with higher *Echinococcus* spp. infection [11]" had been incorrectly written as "Dogs being male and older are two significant factors associated with higher *Echinococcus* spp. infection [11]";

While the sentence "As to the age bias, the infection burden of *E. granulosus* could be significantly lower in dogs over five years-old, but not significant for *E. multilocularis* infection [11, 20]" had been given incorrectly as "As to the age bias, the infection burden of *E. granulosus* could be significantly higher in dogs over five years-old, but not significant for *E. multilocularis* infection [11, 20]".
